



Directions

• SUBWAY

Take Subway Line 1[Gyeongbu Line] to Uiwang Station. Exit through Exit 2 and walk 10 minutes to the right or Take a bus from the left bus stop.

• BUS

From Exit 2 of Uiwang Station, take bus numbers 1-1, 1-2, 1-5, or 5. Get off at the Korea National University of Transportation and walk for 3 minutes.

• CAR

Navigation 142 Cheoldobakmulgwan-ro, Uiwang-si, Gyeonggi-do [Woram-dong 374-1]
Exit left from the Bugok IC on the Yeongdong Expressway towards Uiwang Station and the Railroad Museum.

RAILROAD MUSEUM INTRODUCTION




The Railroad Museum was established to commemorate over 120 years of railway history since the beginning of Korea's railways in 1899. It serves as a cultural space that preserves and exhibits various historical railway artifacts, including actual railway vehicles that played a crucial role in passenger and freight transportation.

Central Hall

The Central Hall displays a photograph of the groundbreaking ceremony of the Gyeongin Railway, a cherished dream of the Korean Empire, along with a 1/5 scale model of the Pacific Class steam locomotive.



History Room

Here, visitors can witness the marks left by railway traffic over the 120 years since the beginning of Korea's railway history on September 18, 1899.




Rolling Stock Room

The Rolling Stock Room allows visitors to learn about the development of Korean railway vehicles, from steam locomotives to KTX trains, and the principles of train operation.



Train Driver Experience Room/Model Train Diorama

Visitors can experience operating electric trains and watch model trains in action in the railroad diorama room.



Electrical Room

This room introduces the advancements in railway electricity, signaling, and communication technologies that contribute to trains' fast and safe operation.



Transportation Services Room

This room highlights the evolution of station and operation work for passenger and freight transport and introduces the joy of train travel.



Multimedia Room

The Video Experience Room showcases railway-related video content and hosts special exhibitions for a limited time.



Facilities Room

This room presents the composition and development process of railway structures such as tracks, stations, bridges, and tunnels.

Observe models of major Korean trains in motion from the past to the present, sparking an interest in railroad history through an audiovisual display.


